Dear Parents and members of our school community,

As some of you will have heard from the Prime Minister's announcement last night or from stories in the press since then, there is a now the beginning of a plan to start coming out of lockdown which includes looking towards reopening schools. We are expecting to hear more details in the coming days and weeks as to how this will look.
