Confirmation of School Reopening on June 1st for children in Pre-School, Reception and Year 1

Dear Parents,

This letter is a follow up to the information sent home last Friday to confirm, that following the Prime Minister's announcement last night- Thursday 28th May 2020, we will be reopening Cheselbourne Village School to children in Pre-School, Reception and Year 1 on Monday 1st June 2020.

Please ensure that you have familiarised yourself with all the details sent home last week as the new systems explained in those documents will come into force from Monday morning.

We will also be launching our new 'Golden Rules' to help support children with their return to school under the new and different circumstances. The 'Be Ready, Be Respectful, Be Safe' motto is something the children in Butterfly Class will have heard before but from now, will be used to help children understand the steps we all need to take to keep as safe as possible in school whilst the concerns around coronavirus remain.



For parents of children in the year groups named above, if you are not intending to send your child in on Monday, please could we ask that you to let us know. There is no penalty for non-attendance at this time and we support parents in making decisions that suit the individual needs of their family, but we just need to keep a record of this so we can account for all children registered at CVS. Thank you.
