After half term we will be exploring the traditional tale of Rapunzel before creating our own modern version. We will finish the term with some Christmas poetry.</p> <p>We will continue to work on developing neat handwriting and making sure we can spell the Year 1 and 2 Common Exception Words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>ICT</u></b> <b>Miss Taylor</b></p> <p>In ICT this term we will be developing the children's literacy skills using a computer, digital camera and ipad. To link in with our art we will be talking selfies.</p> <p>We will continue to teach the children how to use the Internet safely.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Religious Education</u></b> <b>Miss Taylor</b></p> <p>In R.E we will be learning about the Creation story and explore how this influences how Christians behave towards nature and the environment.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Numeracy</u></b> <b>Mrs Collett</b></p> <p>In Numeracy this term we will be exploring and expanding our knowledge of place value. We will look at numbers up to 100, and find more and less than. We will then develop our understanding of addition and subtraction. We will use objects to help us add and subtract, before moving on to using our number fact knowledge.</p> <p>We will also be continuing to work through our 2, 4, 5 and 10 times tables.</p>
