


<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p>In Literacy this term we will be exploring developing our understanding of sentence structures, creating magical stories and animal reports. After half term we will be create historical diary entries and exploring Christmas poetry.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>ICT</u></b> <b>Mrs Collett</b></p> <p>In ICT this term we will be addressing internet safety and how we share information. Following this we will start to explore how we use computers and devices to improve key computing skills.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Religious Education</u></b> <b>Mrs Collett</b></p> <p>For RE this term we will be looking at the special relationship Jews have with God. After half term we will explore what the most significant part of the nativity story is for Christians today.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Numeracy</u></b></p> <p>In Numeracy with Mrs Collett this term we will be exploring and expanding our knowledge of place value. We will also start to develop our mental and written methods for dealing with addition and subtraction problems.</p> <p>With Mrs See we will be learning about Shape and Measure, focusing on telling the time and understanding calendars and dates.</p> <p>We will also be working through our times tables up to 12x12 (for Y4) and completing a multiplication grid challenge each week. Y4 need to work towards completing this objective ready for the government set multiplication test at the end of Y4.</p>

We will be planning fair test activities to share our knowledge of forces with others.
