Dear Parents

Thank you for your ongoing support as schools continue to manage COVID. We have received updated advice from the South West Directors of Public Health. Schools have been asked to

continue their tighter COVID-prevention measures until the end of November. This is because Dorset cases are still well above average for England and the South West generally.

We therefore require parents' continued support with the following:


1. Get a PCR test for everyone in your household if anyone has symptoms which might be COVID.
2. Keep your child at home if they have tested positive or have symptoms.
3. Children who have no symptoms but are waiting for a PCR test result are encouraged to take daily lateral flow tests. It is fine to use these lateral flow tests with younger children (if they allow you to do so, of course – for some children, this may not be appropriate and that is fine and understood).
4. Siblings of children who are positive are also encouraged to take daily lateral flow tests. 5. Test everyone in the household twice weekly with rapid lateral flow tests.

We will be planning for some Christmas events in school but unfortunately these will be under tighter COVID measures. We will be in touch soon to let you know what we are able to do in school. We will still have lots of lovely Christmas events in school but we have to be aware of the prevalence of COVID and things might look different to what we would normally do. I know we all thought this Christmas might be normal again but with the high case rates we have to keep everyone safe.
