



<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>In Literacy this term we will be exploring the text How to train a Dragon. Through this book and experience we will be exploring a variety of writing types, such as letter writing, poetry, reports, instructional texts and story writing.</p>	<p><u>ICT</u> Mrs Collett</p> <p>In ICT this term we will be exploring Digital imagery and media –with stop motion Lego stories.</p>	<p><u>Religious Education</u> Mrs Collett</p> <p>For RE this term we will be looking at Hindu beliefs. After half term we will be discussing Pilgrimage to the River Ganges.</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>In Numeracy with Mrs Collett this term we will be exploring and developing our understanding of fractions and decimals. We will then work on our understanding of negative numbers and further our usage of reasoning in problem solving.</p> <p>With Mrs See we will be focusing on measurement, learning about different units of measure, area and perimeter and then statistics.</p> <p>We will also be working through our times tables up to 12x12 (for Y4) and completing a multiplication grid challenge each week.</p>	
<p><u>Science</u> Mrs Collett</p> <p>In Science this term we will discover the makeup of plants; how they transport water and how they pollinate.
