UTESELBOUR The children and staff have enjoyed a brilliant first week at Cheselbourne School of Witchraft and Wizardry. It was wonderful to see the excitement as they arrived on Monday morning, some of the AGE SCHOOL - children with their letters clutched in their hands! This has inspired a week of learning, predominantly around Literacy but has also included others subjects such as levitation and potion making in Science. The aim of weeks like this is to inspire the children in their attitude towards their learning and encourage them to strive to do the best they can. 
