

Dear Parents,



Well done to all those who took part in the Summer Reading Challenge. We had 15 (not 14 as originally thought by the library) children take part this year which represents nearly half our school so we are really pleased with the number who joined in. All the children have been awarded a certificate to mark their achievement. We hope it has inspired



more children to get involved with the library to borrow books or audio books but to also take part in the large variety of clubs on offer there! Posters for clubs are up in our gazebo notice board and will be sent out with this letter.

**Keeping Safe** - this week we launched a theme of learning that will be covered throughout the whole year through our PHSE work- 'how to keep safe'. This is a huge area of learning covering a whole range of topics including health and safety, online safety, fire safety, healthy relationships, road safety, how to safeguard ourselves and each other and what to do if we're worried about something. We have launched this learning with understanding who are trusted people that we can rely on and go to for help and have used the idea of circles or zones around each individual to help understand this. We have also looked at fire safety as Y1-Y4 are currently learning about themes relating to fire in their history topic work—Y1/2 The Great Fire of London and Y3/4 The Blitz in WW2. To support this learning we have sent home a whole school homework for this for children to speak to their growns to find out a bit more about how we keep safe with fire at home. We would appreciate your support in talking through this with your child(ren) at home. Thank you.
