

STEM Work - This term our learning focus is Science and Mathematics and so we launched our STEM work last Monday. *Home Learning Task 1* has produced some fantastic results with real creativity and thoughtful STEM thinking behind them.

Football Mascot Opportunity - Saturday 16th March

Children from Cheselbourne Village School have the opportunity to be the mascots at Dorchester Town Football Clubs match against Basingstoke on Saturday 16th March. On that day children will need to be dropped off at DTFC at 2pm ready to go onto the pitch with players before the match. They will then watch the match and have the chance to join in a penalty shoot out at half time. We are offering this for children from Y2 and up and there are only 13 space available. If your child is interested in attending please see Mrs White and she can add your child's name to the list. If we have more than 13 children to make it fair who we choose we will put all the children's names in a hat and pull out the first 13. We won't have any adults tickets provided with this and if adults would like to attend they will have to buy tickets for the match on the gate or return to pick up their children after the match. Once we know the 13 children a separate letter with full details for the day will come home.

Just a few reminders...

Timings for the day - Our school day starts at 8:45am and we always plan in learning activities from this time. This important early learning session helps settle the children and set them up for the day so we urge parents to get children to school for that time please.

Uniform - The expectations for uniform is on our school website, please could children come to school in correct uniform, including for PE where a light blue t-shirt is needed. If children are cold please you ensure they have blue, black or grey jogging bottoms. We currently have a large number of children wearing tights with shorts over the top which is not suitable as we have gymnastics where the children need bare feet. Many thanks for your support with this.

We also now have new Caterpillar Preschool uniform available from local uniform provider Wainwrights. This is optional for pre-schoolers but the chance for the children to get used to wearing some uniform before they start 'big' school is always helpful for that transition. T-shirts (£5) and sweatshirts (£9) can be ordered from Mrs White in the office. (Sizes - Age 3/4 or 5/6)

Spellings - for this term are linking into our STEM focus—all Mathematical and Scientific words that children are expected to spell and understand. Alongside the usual weekly wordlists will be Common Exception/High Frequency words stickers stuck in to Reading Records/Spelling books to help learn as an ongoing focus alongside reading.
