Dear Parents,

Characteristics of Effective Learning - in school we have launched a focus on ways in which we learn. This is to develop different styles and approaches to learning, promoting both, ways of learning in which the children already feel comfortable but also to develop learning that they may not be so confident in. The aim of this is to support children become confident and effective in all that they do. We are using the animal characteristics as shown in the picture. Next week each child will receive a record card and will collect stickers for each learning style as they are observed completing these. We look forward to seeing how they do.

NEXT WEEK! Bike Day - since the field is currently out of action and as an opportunity to trial something that could become a regular event, we will be holding a 'Bike Day' this coming **Thursday 23rd May** (last Thursday of this half term). On this day if children would like to, they can bring their bike or scooter (and safety helmet) to school to ride around at playtime. We will be opening up the front

playground too to give plenty of room and also ensure that there is plenty of adult supervision for the safety of all children during 'bike time'. There will also be a designated space for children who choose not to bring a bike or scooter on the day. This is to support our ongoing work promoting healthy and fit lifestyles, as well as hopefully be lots of fun. If you're child is still learning to ride their bike please let us know and we can help support them with this on the day too.

Notes about Bike Day:

- For bus children –they are not able to bring their bike/scooter on bus but parents are welcome to drop a bike off for them earlier in the week if they are driving past the school.
- No motorised scooters please pedal and push power only.


