Dear Parents,

**Sports Day -** Next Friday 5th July is our Sports Day. Due to the village hall field being out of action at the moment I have arranged with the Parish Council for our Sports Day this year to take place in the Village Playground in Streetway Lane. We had a practise today and it went very well. Below is the order for the day:

- \* 12 pm pre-Sports Day family picnic on the school playground (so all parents can see our new playground equipment and also so we can make use of the school kitchen and toilet facilities as the playground does not have these).
- \* 12:30pm parents are invited to head up to the playground to get ready for the start of Sports Day.
- \* 12:45pm The children will get ready and then we will have a procession up the road.
- \* 1pm Sports Day starts, multi-skill and athletic events and then the races. There will be a break from 1:45-2pm for refreshments and for a chance for anyone to head back to the village hall to use the toilet facilities.

We hope the weather stays good for us and all the arrangements work out. If we do have to postpone due to poor weather we will inform you the day before. For Sports Day the children will be competing in their house teams and therefore please could we request that your child comes to school that day in their usual PE kit but with a t-shirt of their house colour. Willow- Blue, Cherry- Red, Sycamore-Green and Copper Beech- yellow. On the day children can come to school like usual on a Friday in this kit, with school shorts and trainers. They need to have had sun cream applied and bring a water bottle and sunhat which they will take with them to the field.
