


<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>In Literacy this term we will be writing imaginative descriptions inspired by the book Bog Baby, writing our own quest tale based on the The Papaya Who Spoke, and writing an explanation. At the end of the term we will be having lots of pirate fun writing treasure hunt clues, messages in a bottle, and wanted posters. We will continue to work on developing neat handwriting and making sure we can spell the Year 1 Common Exception Words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>ICT</u></p> <p>In ICT this term we will be using the skills we learnt about programming before Easter to program and debug beebots. After half term we will be learning to use multimedia to tell a story. We will be learning how to make a powerpoint and how to add text and images.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Religious Education</u></p> <p>The children will be learning about what life is like for a Jewish child this term, focusing on the Shabbat and why people celebrate it. After half term they will learn about another Jewish celebration - Channukah</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>In Numeracy, Year 1 will be working with numbers within 100 and learning methods to add and subtract larger numbers. They will use number fact knowledge by adding across multiples of 10. Yr1 will be doubling and halving and thinking of multiplication as ‘sets of ‘amounts. After the half term will be learning how to apply their skills to solve maths problems and real-life maths investigations.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>In Science this term we will be looking at seasonal changes and daily weather patterns. We will become weather reporters and record observations of the weather at Cheselbourne. We will also be investigating parts of a plant and comparing what parts a flowering plant, non flowering plant and a tree has. We will be planting a bean seed to observe it growing and labelling the parts as it grows. We will be learning how to use different materials to make sculptures by finding out about different sculptors including Barbara Hepworth and Marc Quinn.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p>In Music this term the children will learn how to get into the groove with different styles of music; Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk, Funk. After half term they will be exploring pulse, rhythm and pitch in different styles of music.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>The children will be using maps and atlases to identify where our closest seaside towns are, and looking at the features of seaside towns and how they contrast to our locality. They will also be learning about various islands around the UK.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>History</u></p> <p>The children will be learning about the history of the seaside and how seaside holidays become popular during the Victorian era. They will learn about some traditional British features of the seaside such as the Punch and Judy show.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Design & Technology</u></p> <p>In Design and Technology this term we will be learning how to sew a glove puppet. We will be learning how to do a running stitch and an over stitch before we design, make and evaluate our own puppet.</p>
