We will be producing newspaper reports, letters and our own knight tales.</p> <p>After half term we will be producing our own narrative poems and creating adventure stories.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>ICT</u></b> <b>Mrs Collett</b></p> <p>In ICT this term we will continue to explore online safety. We will also be looking at coding. We will discover why it is used and how we can produce our own codes to create explorer games.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Religious Education</u></b> <b>Mrs See</b></p> <p>For RE this term we will be looking at the important Jewish festival of Passover. After half term we will explore the Easter story, particularly asking the question, is forgiveness always possible?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Numeracy</u></b></p> <p>In Numeracy with Mrs Collett this term we will be exploring and expanding our knowledge of mental and written methods for dealing with multiplication and division problems. After half term we will be investigating fractions and problem solving in different ways. With Mrs See we will be learning about measure.</p> <p>We will also be continuing to work through our times tables up to 12x12 (for Y4) and completing a multiplication grid challenge each week. Y4 need to work towards completing this objective ready for the government set multiplication test at the end of Y4.</p>

We will design and build an Anglo-Saxon house and learn about the creative techniques used by the anglo-saxons to make jewellery, clothing and weapons, having a go at using these techniques ourselves too.</p>

In art we will continue to develop our techniques of sketching and learn about how we can sketch people and anglo-saxon objects.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Music</u></b> <b>Mrs Collett</b></p> <p>In music this term we will be exploring melodies and scales.</p> <p>After half term we will be exploring how to represent colours through sound.</p> <p>Throughout this term we will also be preparing for the Year 3/4 Singing concert and our Easter service.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Humanities</u></b> <b>Mrs See</b></p> <p><i>History:</i> This term we will be learning all about the Anglo-Saxons, linking with our learning about King Arthur.</p> <p><i>Geography:</i> Starting with the great explorations of the Anglo-Saxons and their predecessors the Celts and Romans, we will look at how the United Kingdom and all the places within it have developed over time to present day.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Modern Foreign Languages:</u></b> <b>French and British Sign Language (BSL)</b> <b>Mrs See</b></p> <p>In French we will continue learning conversational phrases, numbers and colours.</p> <p>In BSL we will learn how to sign the alphabet and phrases to greet people who might be deaf.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>PE &amp; Games</u></b></p> <p>With Mr Voss we will be developing the different ball skills and techniques we use in ball games and with Mr Treble we will be learning about different types of dance and creating our own routines.
