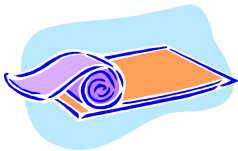


Free Family art workshops

Free Yoga workshop

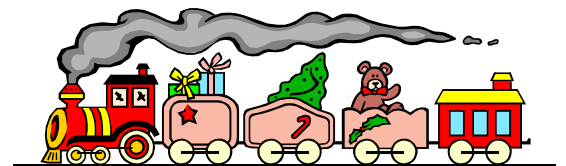

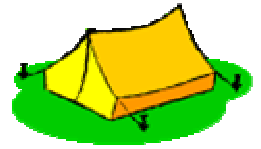


New Books in the Foyer
