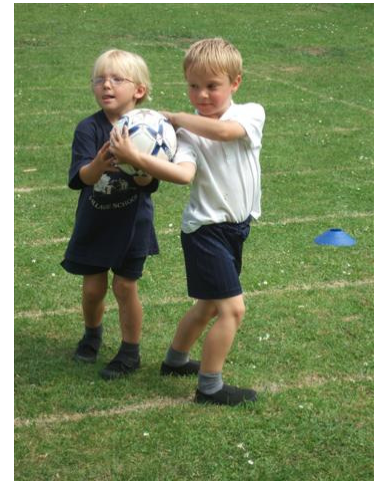


Well it's the beginning of August and I'm loving the holidays - even the rainy days. I do hope you're all having a great time too.
